Advertisement for admission to Ph.D Programme in Education, 2022

Applications are invited for admission to Ph. D programme in Education, Department of Education, University of Calcutta, 1, Reformatory Street, Kolkata – 27. The proforma for application is available in the University website www.caluniv.ac.in. Application form duly filled in together with receipt of Rs. 100/- paid online through SBI Collect (<https://www.onlinesbi.com>) SB Collect – payment for miscellaneous fees – application for admission to Ph. D) are to be submitted to the following e-mail id: educationphd2022@gmail.com within 28. 02. 2022.

Kindly note that the entire application along with all documents need to be submitted in pdf format as one attachment in one email.

The admission to the Ph. D programme is guided by the ‘**University of Calcutta (Regulation for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy, Ph. D), Regulation 2016**’ and other relevant rules of the University. Admission to the programme will be given after a written Entrance Test (RET) followed by a persona; interview (viva).

Eligibility: -

Eligible candidates shall have Master’s Degree in Education/M.Ed with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade B+ in the UGC 7 point scale or an equivalent grade in a point scale where ever grading system is followed. A relaxation of 5% marks, from 55% to 50% or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Differently abled candidates as per UGC guidelines. Those candidates who have already passed UGC/CSIR (JRF) examinations NET/SET/SLET/M.Phil, Teacher Fellow in **Education** need not appear at the written examination and can directly apply to appear at the interview. Reservation policy will be followed as per West Bengal Higher Educational Institution (Reservation in admission) Rules, 2013. All those called for interview will have to submit a statement of purpose of research in brief and appear in the interview on the specified date.

Procedure for RET: -

A **written test** will be held for 50 marks with duration of 1 hour through online. The questions for the Entrance Test will be based on NET syllabus in Education, University of Calcutta.

Qualifying marks for Entrance Test: -

50% for general category and 45% for SC/ST/OBC/Differently abled category.

Interview (viva) of 50 marks: -

All the candidates who qualify in the Entrance Test/RET and the candidates who are exempted from the Entrance Test under the **Regulation for the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy Ph. D**

Regulation 2016 of Calcutta University will have to appear for interview, subject to equivalence clearance from the Register's office, wherever required.

The equivalence clearance may be obtained from the Register's office, University of Calcutta, College Street campus as early as possible and latest before the submission of application form. The final selection for joining this programme and the allocation of the supervisors will be made on the basis of the final interview.

Publication of the final list of candidates qualified for enrolment in the Ph. D programme will be displayed at Departmental notice board and University website as and when approval is received.

Appearing for the interview does not guarantee admission to the Ph. D programme and Ph. D registration.

All in-service applicants, need to attach "**No Objection Certificate**" from the employer at the time of submission of application.

After publication of final result, original documents of the candidate will be verified.
