Advertisement for Admission to Ph.D. Programme, 2019

Applications are invited for admission to Ph.D. Programme in Philosophy, Department of Philosophy, University of Calcutta, 1, Reformatory Street, Kolkata-27. Candidates should apply in the prescribed proforma (www.caluniv.ac.in) by paying Rs.100/- online SBI payment (<https://www.onlinesbi.co>) SB Collect → payment for miscellaneous fees → application for admission to Ph.D.). The eligible candidates will have to appear for a written examination of two hours duration to be held in this Department. The list of successful candidates (written examination) will be displayed on the Notice Board of the Department. Candidates will have to appear for an interview. The final selection for joining this programme will be made on the basis of the interview.

The allocation of supervisors will be on the basis of this interview. **Those candidates who have already passed UGC / CSIR (JRF) Examinations / NET / SET/SLET /M.Phil (Philosophy)/ Teacher Fellowship or equivalent examinations need not appear at the written examination and can directly apply to appear at the interview.**

Important Information :

A) Entrance test (50 marks) will comprise the following:

i) Questions on any topic (30 marks) (from a wide choice of topics in the following areas: Epistemology, Metaphysics, Analytic Philosophy, Philosophy of Wittgenstein, Ethics, Philosophy of Mind, Social & Political Philosophy, Philosophy of Kant, Aristotle (Metaphysics, Ethics & Politics), Phenomenology & Existentialism, Philosophy of Language (Indian and Western), Classical and Contemporary Western Philosophy, Classical and Contemporary Indian Philosophy, Philosophy of Religion, Nyāya-Vaisesika, Vedanta, Comparative Religion, Logic).

ii) Comprehension (20 marks).

B) Interview (**50** marks).

[Specified areas of Research Work: Philosophy of Mind, Ecofeminism in Indian Context, Buddhism / Indian Philosophy (text based study), Ethics, Care Ethics, Applied Ethics, Philosophy of Religion / Comparative Religion (medium English), Logic (Western), Indian Philosophy-Philosophy of Language- preferably Nyaya, Mimamsa texts based].

E) Lists of candidates eligible to appear for the **direct interview & written test** will be put up on **26.09.2019**. **(The list will be displayed in the Department and the University website).**

- H) Interview will be held on **22.10.2019 and 23.10.2019 (if required)** from **12 noon onwards**.
