Introduction of uniform modalities for all PG Courses, both in the University Departments as well as in the affiliated Under-graduate Colleges offering Post Graduate (PG) Courses

- Same Syllabi and CSR for the PG Courses shall be adopted by the University PG Departments as well as by the University affiliated colleges offering PG Courses.
- Examinations shall be held on the same dates and on the same questions following the schedule of examinations to be notified by the University Authorities from time to time.
- PG Board of Studies shall be formed for each course of studies with the faculty members of the concerned PG Departments of the University, and representatives from the University affiliated colleges offering such PG Courses, nominated by the Vice Chancellor, for a period not exceeding four years.
- Head of the University Department shall be the Ex-officio Chairperson
 of the respective PG Board of Studies and meeting of the PG Board of
 Studies be held in the concerned University Department.
- Paper setters, moderators / board of moderators, examiners, head examiners / co-ordinators, scrutineers and re-examiners shall be appointed by the University authorities based on the recommendations of the PG Board of Studies
- Examinations of all papers / subjects / modules including that of Practical / Project papers shall be held in the centres (away centre for affiliated colleges) notified by the University Authorities based on the recommendations of the PG Board of Studies.
- Centralized Admission System shall be followed for admission of the candidates applying for different PG Courses in the University Departments as well as for the admission to the PG Courses in affiliated / constituent colleges, in accordance with the University Admission Regulations and participation of the applicants in the process of Counseling on the dates to be notified by the University Authorities. A team comprising representatives of all the affiliated colleges offering PG Courses and University Departments shall be constituted for the purpose of counseling for admission.
