Notification No. CSR/31/14

It is notified for the information of all concerned that in terms of the provisions of Section 54 of the Calcutta University Act, 1979, (as amended), and, in exercise of his powers under 9(6) of the said Act, the Vice-Chancellor has, by an order dated 28.07.2014 and 07.08.2014, approved some amendments in the Comprehensive & Uniform Regulations for Two-Year (Four Semester) M.Sc. / M.A. Course of Studies notified in Notification No.CSR/55/09 dated 25.11.2009 (Clause No.11 - Criteria for re-appearing at supplementary examination) and the clause after amendment is laid down hereinunder:

Amended Clause No.11

"All Supplementary examinations shall be held after six months of the original examination or within three months from the publication of the results of the original examination."

Having failed or absent in maximum two papers/courses a candidate shall be eligible to appear at the supplementary examination.

A candidate who has **failed** in more than two papers can appear at the same semester without attending the classes and cannot appear at the higher semester without clearing that particular semester.

Candidate who fails in one or two papers can clear the paper/s in two more consecutive chances (excluding the main examination) along with higher semester examination. If the candidate is unable to clear the same within two consecutive chances, he shall be dropped from the concerned course.

Failed candidate, intending to re-appear in a subsequent semester have to take permission from the concerned Faculty Secretary through the Head of the Department immediately after publication of result.

The above shall be effective form 2014 and onwards for those who are appearing in the 4^{th} Semester Examination.
