## Notification No. CSR/35/14

It is notified for the information of all concerned that in terms of the provisions of Section 54 of the Calcutta University Act, 1979, (as amended), and, in exercise of his powers under 9(6) of the said Act, the Vice-Chancellor has, by an order dated 27.08.2014, approved some amendments / inclusions in the existing regulations pertaining to B.F.A. course of study under this University as laid down herein under:

## Amendments / Inclusions in the existing Regulations of B.F.A.

## 1. Amendments of Clause: 3 of Notification No.CSR/45/09 dated 22.09.2009

- a) In order to appear at the B.F.A. Part- I/II/III/IV examination, each candidate must attend at least 75% of the both theoretical and practical classes held in the respective year of Study.
- b) A student having percentage of attendance of both theoretical and practical classes below 75% but not below 60% be declared "Non-Collegiate" and shall be allowed to appear at the concerned examination on payment of requisite Non-Collegiate Fee of the University.
- c) A candidate attending less than 60% of theoretical and practical classes shall be declared "Discollegiate" and debarred from appearing at the concerned examination.

However he / she may take readmission in the next year and after attaining requisite attendance may appear at the examination concerned. Attendance shall be counted from the dated of commencement of classes.

2. B.F.A. Part- II/III/IV classes shall commence ordinarily within 7 days after completion of previous examination of the year, and students should report for provisional enrollment to the institution accordingly.

3. Amendment of Clause: 6 of Notification No.CSR/45/09 dated 22.09.2009:

A candidate may seek re-examination of answer-scripts of not more than one theoretical paper of Part- I/II/III/IV provided he/she secures at least 40 percent of the total marks in the remaining theoretical as well as practical papers concerned. However there is no provision for re-examination in practical papers.

4. Amendments of Syllabus (Notification No.CSR/21/04 dated 17.05.2004)

Paper -II in the specialization Course in 'PAINTING' (Indian Style) in Part-IV shall be termed as 'MURAL' instead of 'NATURE STUDY'.

The above shall take immediate effect.
