Regulations of the Internal Assessment (IA) for Issuance of CSR
Notification w.e.f.-2010

1. Internal Assessment (IA) will be held once in each academic session for both M.A. Part-I and Part-II students.
2. In IA the full marks for each paper is 20. Each paper is divided into two halves. Each half consists of two groups. Students have to answer four (4) questions of ten (10) marks each taking one question from each group of each half. And the average of the total marks obtained by the students in each paper will be shown in the final mark sheet.
3. IA will be held at least three (3) months prior to the commencement of M.A. Part-I and M.A. Part-II final examination.
4. Unless a student appears in IA (in all papers) he / she will not be considered eligible to appear for the final (M.A. Part-I and Part-II) examinations.
5. a) Supplementary IA will be held after the completion of IA. Supplementary IA will be held once only for those students who could not appear in the Internal Assessment examination due to illness or some unavoidable circumstances. The concerned candidates will have to inform the Head of the Department, in writing, the reason of his/ her inability to appear in the said IA within a week from the commencement of the said examination.

b) A candidate who appeared in some paper(s) of the IA but could not appear in all the papers due to illness or some unavoidable circumstances, will be given the opportunity to appear in the supplementary IA only in those paper(s) in which he /she could not appear earlier (in the same academic session). In the case of such candidates also prior intimation to the Head of the Department (as mentioned in para 5(a) above) will be required.
6. There will be no provision for review/ scrutiny of the scripts of Internal Assessment and Supplementary IA.
7. The marks obtained by a candidate in the IA will not be published before the publication of the final results of M.A. Part-I and Part-II examinations respectively. The marks obtained by a student in each paper in IA will be shown separately in the final mark sheet.
