It is notified for the information of all concerned that in terms of the provisions of Section 54 of the Calcutta University Act, 1979, (as amended), and, in exercise of his powers under 9(6) of the said Act, the Vice-Chancellor has, by orders dated 25.09.2013, approved certain amendments to the existing regulations (regarding restructuring of course pattern and revision of nomenclature) notified under Notification No.CSR/1/13 dated 04.01.2013 pertaining Master of Library & Information Science (MLIS) course of study under this University, as laid down in the accompanying pamphlet.

The above will take immediate effect.

Existing Pattern as per Notification No. CSR/01/13

Regulations

1. Nomenclature, exit option and phoenix entry option

The degree of Master of Library & Information Science (MLIS) course of the University of Calcutta shall be awarded to a candidate who has completed a regular course of study for not less than five years and qualified the examinations after Semester-1, Semester-2, Semester-3, Semester-4, Semester-5, Semester-6, Semester-7, Semester-8, Semester-9 and Semester-10 held at such time and place and in the such manner as prescribed by the appropriate authority of the University from time to time.

At the end of 4 years, after successful completion of 8 semesters, any candidate may take the exit option.

After successful completion of 8 semesters, all candidates will be awarded the degree in the nomenclature of Bachelor of Library & Information Science (Honours).

There may be provision of phoenix entry for taking admission in the 5th year for the students who would take exit option after 4 years (but never the intake number would exceed 5).

To Be Revised

Regulations

1. Nomenclature, exit option and phoenix entry option

The degree of Master of Library & Information Science (MLIS) course of the University of Calcutta shall be awarded to a candidate who has completed a regular course of study for not less than five years and qualified the examinations after Semester-1, Semester-2, Semester-3, Semester-4, Semester-5, Semester-6, Semester-7, Semester-8, Semester-9 and Semester-10 held at such time and place and in the such manner as prescribed by the appropriate authority of the University from time to time.

At the end of 3 years, after successful completion of 6 semesters, any candidate may take the exit option.

After successful completion of 6 semesters, all candidates will be awarded the degree in the nomenclature of Bachelor of Library & Information Science (Honours) / BLIS (Honours).

After successful completion of 8 semesters, all candidates will be awarded the degree in the nomenclature of Advanced Bachelor of Library & Information Science / Advanced BLIS.

There may be provision of phoenix entry for taking admission in the 4th or 5th year for the students who would take exit option after 3 or 4 years (but never the intake number would exceed 5).
